STOUGHTON, MA – The Norfolk County Sheriff's Office will host a veterans-focused "House to House for Heroes" in Stoughton on Saturday, September 6th, with volunteers visiting the homes of local veterans to hand-deliver vital information about the resources and new benefits available to them.

House to House for Heroes in Stoughton will begin at 9:00 a.m. with a ceremony at VFW Post 1645 located at 14 Seaver Street in Stoughton. Volunteers will then head out into neighborhoods to connect with veterans, in partnership with the Stoughton Veterans' Service Office.

Volunteers will deliver a packet of information that includes helpful details about how to apply for assistance and health benefits from Veterans Affairs, details about housing and employment opportunities, information about newly available state benefits, a letter thanking them for their service, and contacts for many veteran-based agencies.

The Hero Act, signed by the Healey-Driscoll Administration in 2024, affects hundreds of thousands of veterans across Massachusetts, and the Norfolk County Sheriff's Office wants to make sure they are aware of these landmark new benefits.
